

Most pianos are built using serial numbers between 4 and 20. The earliest serial numbers were usually assigned to pianos when they were sold at their first factory. As more factories were built, they were assigned to each piano as it came off the line. Once all of the pianos for a new factory were assigned, they were assigned a new serial number. In the late 1800s, serial numbers continued to be assigned based on the factory that the piano was being built for. The factory usually assigned serial numbers to only one piano at a time. The first factory to assign serial numbers to all of its pianos had only one factory number. Once the factory changed owners or merged with another company, it might assign one factory number to all of the pianos it produced. The factory might give the serial number to pianos when they were sold to the customer. The serial number usually consists of a three or four digit number and a letter. The most common number sequence is: ****3 digits**** The first digit is the number of the factory that built the piano. The second and third digits are used to help identify a specific piano from the factory. Each factory has a unique sequence for its serial numbers. The two and three digit numbers are assigned in a specific order for the factory. For example, when a factory is producing a range of pianos, it might assign serial numbers in the following order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, etc. The piano that was produced on the 10th piano built at the factory would have a serial number of 10, 11, 12, etc. As serial numbers can be used to identify a specific piano, they are also helpful when identifying a stolen piano. Finding the serial number of a piano is easy when the piano is in its original packaging. For example, a piano that is in its original case and box can be easily identified by searching for the serial number printed on the front of the piano case. If the piano is in a pawn shop or second hand store, the serial number might be lost. For example, once a piano was stolen, the thief might have removed the case and other identifying information. Piano serial numbers are assigned to a piano based on the factory where it was built. The first serial number was assigned to the piano when it was sold at the first factory. The serial numbers are assigned 82157476af
